GLORIA CAMPANER (Italy)

25 years old, Gloria CAMPANER was born in Venice. She is considered by the public and critics one of the most talented young pianists of the new generation. She won the first prize in more than twenty national and international piano competitions for young musicians. Her rapidly advancing career as soloist with orchestra in Italy abroad: Japan, Israel, Turkey, England, Ireland, Germany, Switzerland, France and Brazil. Moreover Gloria has a long collaboration with choreographer and dancer Joost VROUNRAETS of the "Maurice BEJART Ballet Lausanne" with whom she elaborates spectacles of contemporary music and dance.



JULIEN FAURE (France)

32 years old. Julien FAURE started his studies when he was 5 years old. He worked with Brigitte Engerer at the CNSM in Paris and after that he studied with Frédéric Aguessy and György Sándor in Geneva, then in the Royal College of Music in London. He was the second prize winner at the Vasso Devetzi Competition. He performs regularly and is also a music composer.



MATIAS ALZOLA (Austria)

22 years old Matthias began piano studies in Chilli before going to Switzerland then Austria, finalist in the Claudia Arran International Competition. This summer he won the First Prize of the Finnish Piano Competition.



JOANNA SOCHACKA (Poland)

18 years old. Joanna is actually student in the Music School of Second Musical Degree in Cracow. She is studying the piano since the age of 8. She is a prize winner of many competitions for young musicians in Narva (Estonia), Castellana Grotte (Italy), Lodz, Warsaw, Kielce, Szafarnia, Cracow, chamber music competitions and performances with orchestra. She regularly plays at many festivals, concerts and events in Poland and abroad, also Piano Plage Festival 2010 in France. Since 2008 she is a participant of Polish organization for the most talented students, and stipendist of many foundations for young artist.



PIOTR JAWORSKI (Poland)

16 years old. Since 2002, he attended the piano class of mgr Jolanta Trybus at Primary Music State School in Jasło. In 2008 and 2009 he participated in the Summer Courses of the Witold Lutosławski Cracow Conservatory in Mariusz Sielski piano class. In 2005, 2006, 2008 and 2010 he took part in the all-Polish Competition for Young Instrumentalists in Jasło, and in 2010 he won the award. In 2008 he participated in the National Chamber Music Competition for young secondary music schools "Around Vivaldi". In 2010 he participated in the XVIII International Chopin Competition for Children and Youth in Szafarnia. In the same year he won the second prize (first award wasn't presented) at the First Chopin Piano Tournament of Halina and Ludwik Stefański in Krakow. Currently student of private Secondary Music School in Jasło – piano class of ad. Mariusz Sielski.



XÉNIA STOLEARCIUC (Moldavia)

24 years old. Xénia graduated of the Academy of Music, Theatre and Fine Arts of Moldavia. She won many piano Prizes in Moldavia and Rumania. She performs regularly with Philharmonic Orchestras as the National Orchestra of Moldavia and of Lunchevici and participated at many Festivals ias the Piano Plage Festival 2010 in France.



LIRA CEBAN (Moldavia)

21 years old. Lira terminates her studies at the Academy of Music, Theatre and Fine Arts of Moldavia. Third Prize at the Eugen COCA International Competition. She regularly takes part in numerous festivals in Moldavia, Rumania and Austria.
